- Finished Hogs for Restaurant Use: 125lb hogs are being sold for \$7.50/lb to a restaurant in Illinois. The restaurant wants the entire hog from nose to tail.
- Registration Letter: Teresa Hord brought up adding a form letter with the litter registration paperwork explaining the next step to register individual hogs and a thank you letter included with the hog registration paperwork. Teresa was going to write up a letter and send it to the board members to review.
- Transfer of Hogs: Jesse brought up how he feels that we should be handing the registration paperwork over to the buyer upon pick up of hog and have the buyer send in the papers. He feels that by the seller sending in the paperwork it leaves the buyer thinking they might not get the registration paperwork. We discussed looking into how other registries (like AKC) that have "litters" do their registration.
